



Introduction

Our school is a government-subsidized Christian secondary school. With the love of Jesus Christ, we carry out whole-person education with exemplary educational ideals. Our school is committed to providing an ideal learning environment, guiding students to understanding the truth about the Gospel of Christ, and broadening students' horizons about China and the world. We aim at developing students' multiple intelligences, and teaching them the virtues of being a good citizen, so that they can contribute to our society and country.

The school focuses on the formal instruction of Chinese, English, Mathematics and critical thinking in junior forms (S.1-S.3). In senior forms (S.4-S.6), we focus on deepening subject knowledge, thereby allowing students to excel in public examinations. Under the Medium of Instruction Fine Tuning policy, S.1-3 Mathematics and Science are taught in English, and English classes are set up in junior forms. All subjects are taught in English (except for Chinese, Chinese History, Putonghua, and Religious Education). In addition to textbooks, teachers use school-based materials and activities to strengthen students' critical and independent thinking, thus laying the foundation for lifelong learning. The school has implemented the new senior secondary system and renewal of school curriculum. The results of the HKDSE are satisfactory, and most S.6 graduates continue their studies in various tertiary institutions.

Applicant Eligibility and Procedures

In the academic year 2023/24, there will be 4 classes of Secondary One. 30% of the S.1 places will be allocated to Primary 6 students as discretionary places. The number of self-allocated places is 40. Details are as follows:

1. The application form can be downloaded from our website or obtained at our General Office.
2. Application submission period: Jan. 3, 2023 to Jan. 17, 2023
3. Please bring the following items to our school:
 - ☞ School Application Form
 - ☞ Application Form for Secondary One Discretionary Places (from the School Places Allocation Section of the EDB)
 - ☞ a copy of the Primary 6 Student Record Form from the Education Bureau
 - ☞ a copy of the Primary 5 report card for both terms
 - ☞ a copy of the Primary 6 first term report card (if issued)
 - ☞ a copy of the HKID card or birth certificate
 - ☞ 2 self-addressed stamped (\$2.2) envelopes
 - ☞ a manila envelope
4. Applicants do not need to provide recommendations from primary schools.
5. Upon receiving the above documents, the school staff will verify them and ask parents to place them inside the manila envelope (unfolded) for the school's records.
6. Once the application form is submitted, it cannot be withdrawn or cancelled.
7. Late applications will not be considered; inadequate copies of documents may affect the eligibility of applicants.

Selection Criteria

The school will select students according to the criteria below:

1. Academic performance (40%)
 2. Personal attribute (20%)
 3. Interview performance (40%)
- * All students who have submitted applications will be interviewed. The date of the interview will be Saturday, March 18, 2022. The school will notify students in writing and text messages at the beginning of March to participate in interviews to assess their Chinese, English and Mathematics skills.

Notes

1. According to the regulations of the Education Bureau, Primary Six students can apply to two subsidized secondary schools for Secondary One Discretionary Places.
2. On March 31, 2023, the school will notify parents of all successful applicants through written or telephone confirmation. The remaining primary allocation results will be announced to P.6 students by their primary schools on July 11, 2023, when the results of the secondary allocation are released. Students and parents are not required to check the application results with our school.
3. Due to the limited number of discretionary places, applicants are strongly encouraged to assign this school as their first choice in the Application Form for Secondary One Discretionary Places, so as to increase their chances of enrollment here.
